introduction. Addresses to these two gardens will be provided at the Regional Meeting Saturday afternoon.

In the hybridizer garden there will be four seedings beds that you will be allowed to dig, bag and purchase plants. Garden fork, scissors and Walmart sized bags will be made available, The cost per bag \$10 for everything you can fit. Yes, you will be able to cut as much foliage off of the plants as you like. All proceeds will go to the Baton Rouge Daylily Society which, in turn, will make a donation to Region 13.
